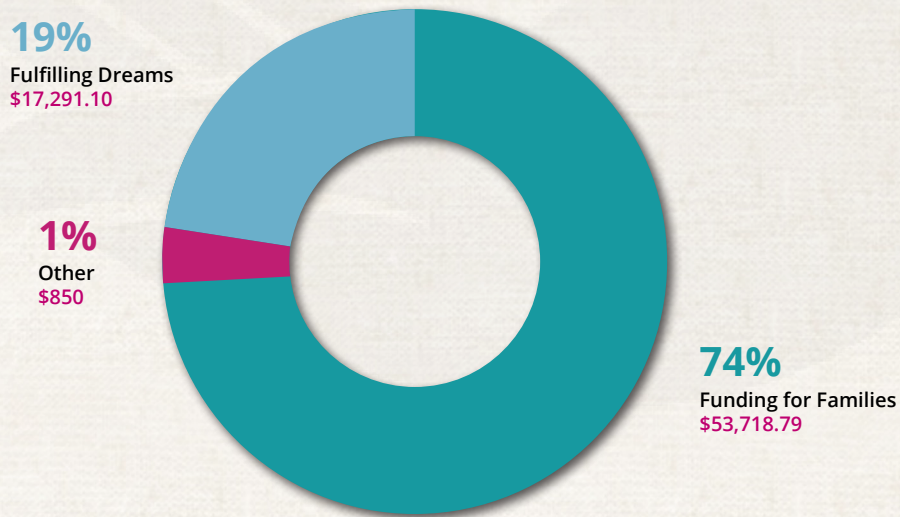

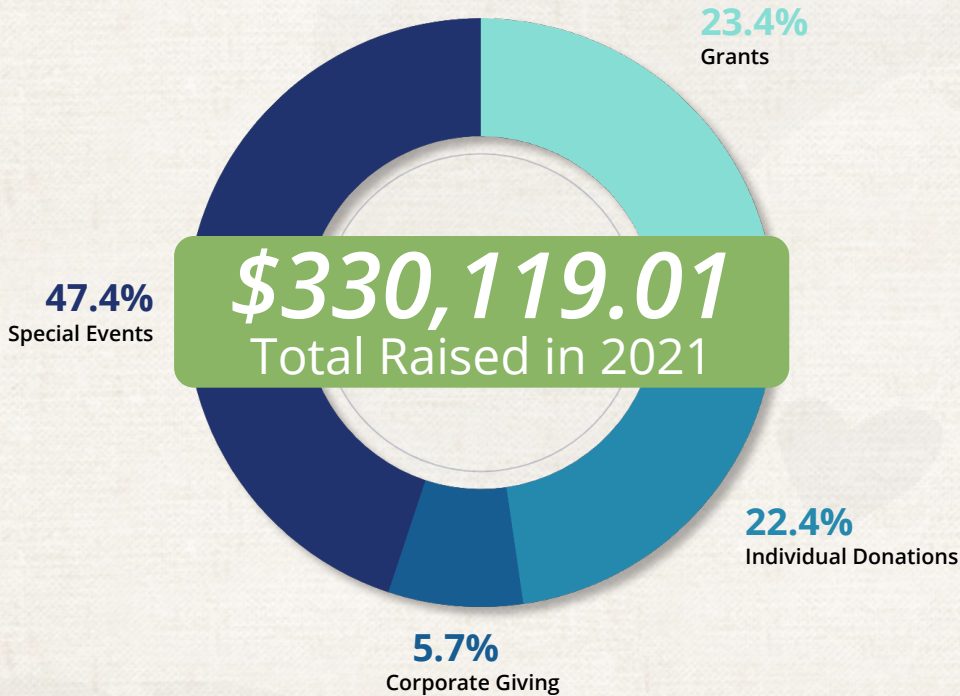
Service Area Breakdown
